GUIDELINES FOR PAPER PRESENTATIONS

- Abstract should be in Times New Roman, font size 12, italicized and not be more than 250 words.
- Full paper should be submitted in MS Word format and should not exceed 3500 words; text should be typed in Times New Roman, font size 12 and all text should be one-and-a half line spaced and fully justified.
- Heading should be bold faced in font size 14, sub heading bold faced and in font size 12
- Each page should be numbered at the bottom on the right side.
- References should be in the APA format.
- Verifiable sources for the secondary information are to be given.
- Cover page should contain title of the paper, author/s' name and affiliation, contact details including mobile number and email address.

- If the paper is co-authored by more than one, all the authors need to be registered individually.
- There will be a video presentation for the selected papers in the technical sessions.
 On the final selection, the presenters shall be informed through mail.
