Concept Note

The International Conference, "Digital Humanities- New Era Education" aims to explore the transformative role of technology in reshaping humanities education, pedagogy, and research in the 21st century. As we navigate through an increasingly digital world, we become witness to the technological inflections of humanities, pedagogies, and paradigmatic changes to the form and contents of the Humanities as a discipline. This phenomenon has its opportunities as well as its challenges. This conference will provide a platform for educators, researchers, and practitioners to engage in probing enquiry into the digital knowledge system based on memory, archives and the signifying powers of multi-media signs. The conference will feature keynote speeches, panel discussions, workshops, and paper presentations, ensuring a diverse and enriching experience for participants. It will also provide a platform for researchers, particularly those from low- and middle-income countries, to showcase their work and gain professional visibility.

2017:	•	The University was inaugurated on July 7 by Dr. Mamata Banerjee, and Fr. Felix Raj, S.J. became the first Vice-Chancellor.

- 5 The font should be **Times New Roman**, Size **12** for the main text, with **1.5 line spacing**. All text should be justified.
- 6 The paper must be between **4000-7000 words**, including references. Referencing should follow the **APA7** style.
- 7 All headings should follow the **Title Case** format (e.g., Digital Humanities).
- 8 The paper must be accompanied by a cover page containing the following details:
 - Title of the Paper
 - Theme of the Paper
 - Name of the Author(s)
 - University/Institution/Organization
 - Email Address
 - Mobile Number
- 9 All entries must be **original** and **unpublished**, and should not have been submitted for publication elsewhere in any form.

Papers must be **plagiarism-free**.

A similarity index up to **10%** and AI-generated content up to **10%** is acceptable.
